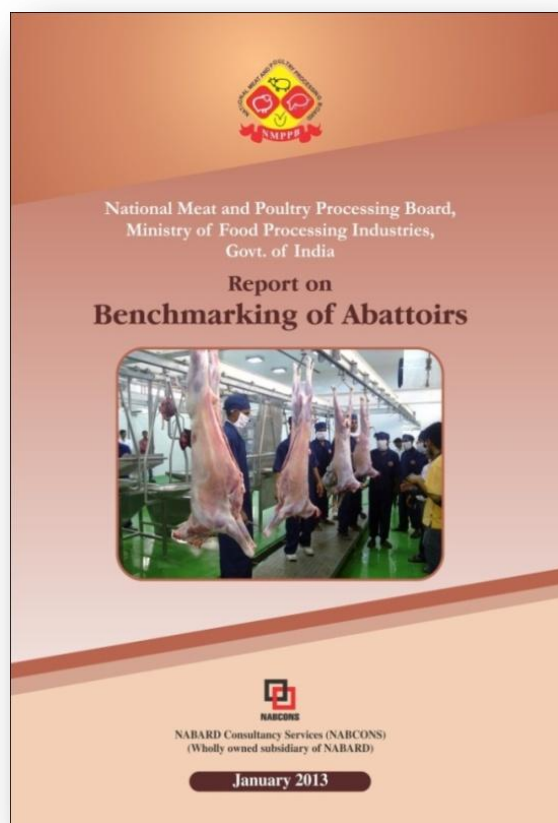


## STUDY REPORT ON “BENCHMARKING OF ABATTOIRS”

Abattoirs are built with necessary infrastructures where all required hygienic practices are to be followed for slaughter of animals and birds for the production of safe clean and hygienic meat for consumption for consumers as well as efficient and economic utilization of the by-products with utmost regard to maintenance of public health and sound environmental management.

Compliance of structural and functional requirements in accordance with quality protocols makes an abattoir acceptable in the location where it is situated.

A detailed study has been conducted on selected abattoirs of India for their compliance with structural and functional requirements under different statutory provisions and adherence to quality protocols like HACCP, ISO 22000:2005,

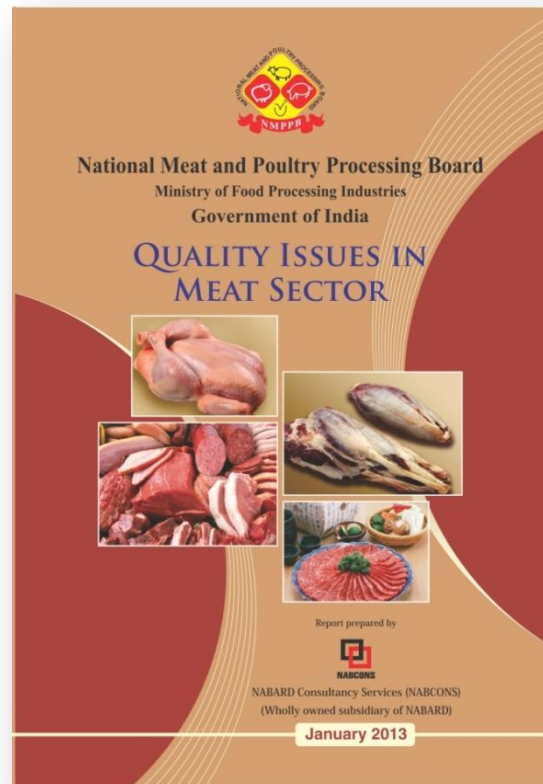
FSMS, GMP and GHP. This may enable introduction of a system of Benchmarking of the Abattoirs to measure achievements in the efforts to develop the meat industry in India on sound footing.

The study report is based on information collected on abattoirs, slaughter establishments and meat stalls and dealt in eight chapters and appended with statutory laws related to transportation and slaughter of meat animals. Necessary recommendations are also made for consideration of various stakeholders of the meat Industry. The study report is presented in a compilation of 348 pages (including appendices and annexure).

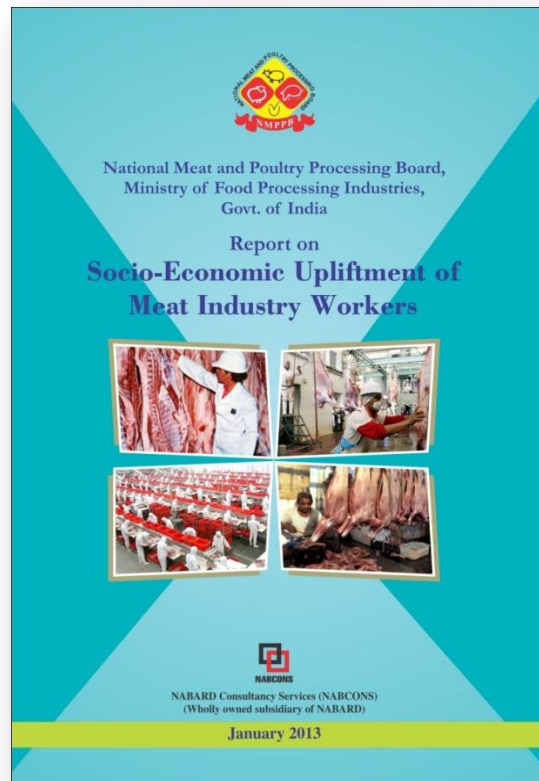

The current status of the Quality Adherence Practices (QAP) followed in various slaughter establishments for different species of meat animals have been studied in depth along with quality issue documents in the report. Recommendations have also been given for implementation of various programmes to achieve desired meat quality.

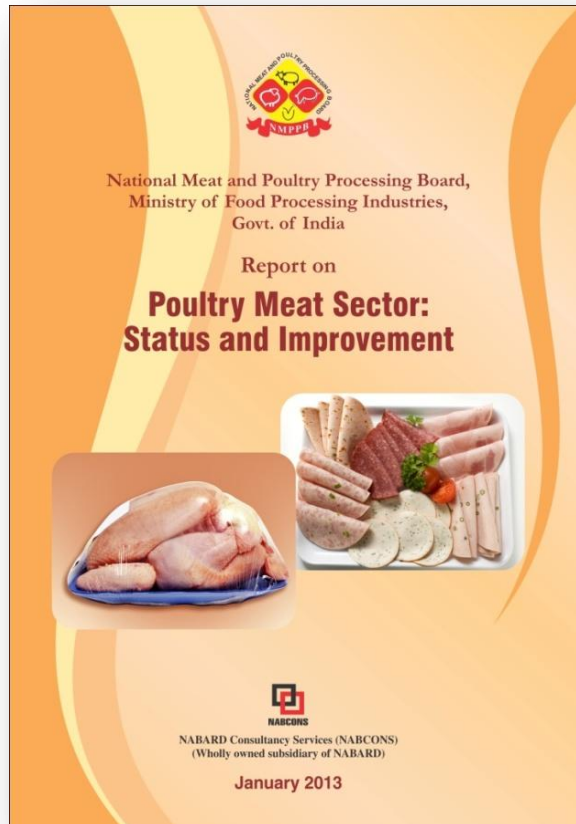
