Dear Sr. Chaitanya,

The National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) Scheme was launched with the aim of preserving and revitalizing the soul of and unique character of the heritage cities in India. Under the Scheme, twelve cities namely, Ajmer, Amritsar, Amaravati, Badami, Dwarka, Gaya, Kanchipuram, Mathura, Puri, Varanasi, Velankanni, Warangal have been identified for development. The scheme will be coming to an end in November, 2018 as it was launched as pilot for a duration of four years.

2. As mentioned above, the city of Gaya from Bihar has been included under HRIDAY scheme. Total outlay of Rs 40.04 Crore was earmarked for the city, out of which Rs. 35 Crore was allocated for project implementation. Four projects amounting to Rs. 34.68 crore, have been approved for Gaya. Based on Utilization certificate received, Rs. 16.86 Crore worth of installments have been already released to Gaya Municipal Corporation which is the City Mission Directorate under HRIDAY scheme. The details of physical and Financial progress and completion dates of these projects is at Annexure - A.

3. The Physical and Financial progress of the above projects were reviewed at my level. It is seen that, till May-2018 only 10% of physical progress is achieved. In this connection, I would like to bring to your notice the following facts:

- Physical progress of projects has a direct bearing over funds utilization. Hence speedy implementation of projects is very critical to ensure that funds budgeted for cities are utilized in a time bound manner.
- The HRIDAY scheme is coming to an end in November, 2018. Before November, 2018, the Ministry needs to disburse all the funds under HRIDAY to the cities. Thereafter, the budget will not be available, which will affect the completion of projects if not completed before.

The pace of execution of projects is to be accelerated so that the target of completing the projects before November, 2018 can be achieved.

**Issues:-**

**(i) Decision on Savings from De-Scoping of Dungeshwari Hill Project:**

"A" | Due to overlapping of scope of work on project of "Development of Connecting pathway - Dungeshwari hill to Mahabodhi temple (Zone-6) at Bodh Gaya" with Road Development Corporation (RDC) under State Government, there is saving of Rs. 8 Crore. The National Mission Directorate of HRIDAY proposed that RDC can take up the work as per their DPR and requested State Government to accept the funding of Rs. 8 Crore from HRIDAY. The State Government is yet to respond to the proposal.

**(ii) Project Progress need to be expedited:**

Total 4 projects amounting to Rs. 34.68 Crore under execution. Overall physical progress of city is only 10%. City Mission Directorate committed to complete 2 projects by month of June and rest of 2 in October, 2018, which does not seems feasible as per actual conditions on ground. Strict monitoring and supervision of the execution from the State Government is also required to complete all the projects within the mission period (November, 2018).
